Co-Director of DPT Clinical Education

CSM is inviting applications for a full-time 12-month non-tenured faculty appointment at the Assistant or Associate Professor rank to teach generalist content and serve as the Co-Director of Clinical Education in the hybrid Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) Program in Omaha, NE. This DPT program is completed in 2.5 years and uses a combination of online and face-to-face learning experiences to educate future practitioners. The blended learning model allows faculty and students to live remotely from campus. DPT faculty must travel to Omaha for designated periods each semester.

Primary Responsibilities Include:

- Serve as the Co-Director of Clinical Education while developing and teaching generalist physical therapy content.
- Participate in faculty-led student research projects, and develop and sustain an independent research agenda.
- In conjunction with the Co-DCE and DPT Program & Clinical Coordinator, organize and manage the efforts of the CSM DPT Program and clinical education sites in the education and preparation of PT students. Please refer to the Co-DCE job description for the complete list of duties.

- The DPT degree or PT (PT or MSPT) degree with an academic terminal degree is required

- Graduate of an accredited clinical residency program preferred
- Board Certified Clinical Specialists preferred
- Minimum of 3 years of experience as a licensed physical therapist

- Prior teaching experience in distance education
