Essential Functions

- Maintain an active relationship with each of the 100-150 major donors and prospective major donors in their portfolio, who will be at various stages of identification, cultivation, solicitation and stewardship.
- The ability to maintain 12-15 donor/alumnae connects/visits each month is essential.
- Oversee the departmental responsibility of accurate records within CSM's fundraising software concerning gift processing, updated contact information, contact logs, etc.
- Seek to grow and diversify the list of individuals and families supporting CSM's mission and build new relationships on behalf of the University.
