College of Saint Mary in Omaha, Nebraska, seeks a full time Business faculty starting August 1, 2020. The successful candidate will teach undergraduate courses in more than one area of the Business curriculum, which offers courses in accounting, e-commerce, finance, business analytics, international business, communication, marketing, human resources management, and leadership. The successful candidate will also be responsible for advising students and fulfilling other duties as assigned or as specified in the Faculty Handbook. The Business faculty reports directly to the Associate Dean for Arts, Sciences and Professional Studies. This is a 10-month appointment.

CSM's Business Program offers students ample focus on Human Resources, Marketing, and Analytics, three areas in which graduates thrive as they develop critical thinking skills throughout the program. Additionally, CSM's Business Program requires more internships than other regional institutions, a distinction that has led to other career opportunities.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: The successful candidate must hold an earned doctorate in Business or a related field, or a DBA from a regionally accredited institution; must be eligible for appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, or Professor; and must have relevant teaching experience.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: Knowledge and experience with accreditation standards and processes, specifically with the International Assembly for Collegiate Business Education (IACBE) are preferred.

PRIMARY DUTIES: The successful candidate will teach twelve (12) credit hours each semester (24 per academic year) and advise students.
