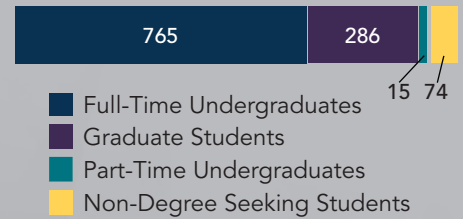

Where are our students from?



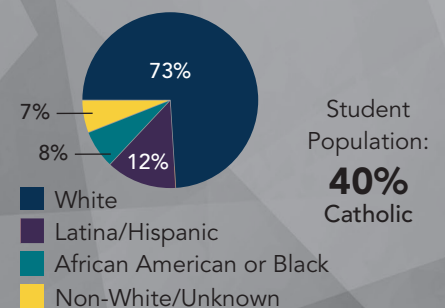
