Students who are listed as “continuing enrollment” may have been counted in a later cohort. The OT program assessment committee will be instituting measures to more closely track and evaluate cohort retention rates for students from Level I through graduation.

The calculation for 2012 and 2011 does not include students who had retaken the exam and passed. NBCOT changed the reporting method in July 2013 and all scores reported as of 2014 are the total number of students who passed the exam regardless of the number of tries. Only 5 students who graduated from the CSM program between 2011 and 2013 have not passed the NBCOT exam yet. This means 115 out of 120 graduates who have taken the NBCOT exam have passed for an overall 3 year pass rate of 96%.
