*Courses require field experience. The following are required before you begin any field experience:

<u>Background Check</u> - In accordance with Nebraska State law, *before participating in any field experience*, students must complete a background check. We have arranged with One Source: The Background Check Company to perform this service for you at a cost of \$26.75.

<u>Liabilty Insurance</u> - Any student *participating in any field experience* must have professional liability insurance. SEAN (Student Education Association of Nebraska) membership provides this insurance. Students must show proof of current SEAN membership or coverage by another insurance carrier prior to participating in *any* field experience. Cost for an academic year membership is \$44. Membership must be renewed for each academic year that you participate in field experience.

Praxis I Core Academic Skills Test for Educators - Take Prior to Fall of Sophomore Year

Teacher education students must take the Praxis Core Skills Test for Educators. This requirement must be completed before students are accepted into teacher education programs at CSM. Students entering as first time, full-time students must provide proof of registration for the test by the end of their second semester and have passing scores by March 1 of the sophomore year. Transfer students should talk with their EDU advisor about when they need to take the test. Minimum passing scores established by the state of Nebraska for the Core Tests are: 156 in reading, 150 in mathematics, 162 in writing.
