### **Geriatric and Acute Care DPT Faculty**

College of Saint Mary is currently inviting applications for a full-time 12-month non-tenured faculty appointment at the Assistant Professor rank to teach geriatric and acute care content for a blended learning Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) Program in Omaha, NE. This DPT program is completed in 2.5 years and uses a combination of online and face-to-face learning experiences to educate future practitioners. The blended learning model allows faculty and students to live remotely from campus. However, DPT faculty must travel to and stay in Omaha for designated periods each semester.

#### **The successful candidate's responsibilities include:**

- Developing and teaching courses related to geriatric and acute care physical therapy, emphasizing examination and intervention of patients/clients with movement dysfunctions
- Participating in faculty-led student research projects, assisting with mentoring in related areas of expertise within the CSM DPT Clinical Education Program, and serving as a clinical instructor in the integrated clinical education experiences.
- The candidate will develop and sustain an independent research agenda.

#### **Our Ideal Candidate's Education and Experience:**

- Graduate of an accredited physical therapist education program
- A terminal academic degree (PhD, EdD, DHSc) is preferred. A clinical doctorate with demonstrated clinical expertise with plans to obtain a terminal academic degree will be considered. All degrees must be earned from an accredited institution.
- Should be licensed or eligible for licensure in Nebraska
- Member of the American Physical Therapy Association
- Prior teaching experience in a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant education program
- Graduate of an accredited acute care or geriatric residency program preferred
- Board Certified Geriatric Clinical Specialist
- Minimum of 5 years of experience as a licensed physical therapist
- Able to work with students with special needs based on the Americans with Disabilities Act
- Prior teaching experience in distance education preferred
- Knowledge of educational management and adult learning theories and principles preferred
