SPECIAL SERVICES COACHING CERTIFICATION AUGUST 2015

Any student who is interested in coaching at a Nebraska High School (7-12) may apply for and obtain a Special Services Coaching Certificate. This certificate is available to all students whether or not they are teacher education majors, but who will coach high school activities in Nebraska schools and therefore need a certificate.

To obtain this certification, students must:

- A. Complete two courses through the NFHS (National Federation of State High School Associations).
 - a. Fundamentals of Coaching course (meets the Nebraska Human Relations requirement) Cost is \$60
 - b. First Aid, Health and Safety for Coaches course Cost is \$55
 - c. The courses are all offered on-line and you are able to work at your own speed.
- B. Apply for the certification online through the Nebraska Department of Education.
 - a. Cost is \$55 (additional \$50 cost for fingerprinting if you have not been a continuous Nebraska resident for the past five years)
 - b. Certification is valid for five years
