Teacher Education Adjuncts Clinical Supervisors Fall 2024

College of Saint Mary Teacher Education Program is seeking university student teaching supervisors for Fall semester 2024.

A university student teaching supervisor observes the student teacher in her school building five times during the fall semester. The supervisor provides feedback, guidance, and online comments. Working in partnership, the supervisor consults with the cooperating teacher to provide support to the student teacher.

- Days and times of observations are to be determined by the student teacher and supervisor.
- Requirements: master's degree and minimum of five years of full-time teaching in a PK-12 classroom.
- All adjunct faculty utilized for clinical experience supervision must hold or have held appropriate certification for the area and/or level they are supervising.

Preference will be given to those candidates with 7-12 secondary English language arts or 5-9 middle level math, though others will be considered.
