Generalist DPT Faculty

College of Saint Mary is currently inviting applications for a full-time 12-month non-tenured faculty appointment at the Assistant or Associate Professor rank to teach generalist content (pathophysiology, pharmacology, integumentary, telehealth) in the blended learning Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) Program in Omaha, NE. This DPT program is completed in 2.5 years and uses a combination of online and face-to-face learning experiences to educate future practitioners. The blended learning model allows faculty and students to live remotely from campus. However, DPT faculty must travel to Omaha for designated periods each semester.

Primary Responsibilities Include:

- Developing and teaching content for pathophysiology, pharmacology, integumentary, telehealth, business, and leadership courses
- Participating in faculty-led student research projects, assist with mentoring in related areas of expertise within the CSM DPT Clinical Education Program, and serving as a clinical instructor in the integrated clinical education experiences
- Developing and sustaining an independent research agenda
