

## **Program Director for Legal Studies**

College of Saint Mary in Omaha, Nebraska, seeks a Program Director for the Legal Studies Program. The Legal Studies Program offers and Associate's degree, Bachelor's degree, and a post-baccalaureate certificate. The Program Director reports directly to the Associate Dean for Arts, Sciences and Professional Studies.

This is a 10-month appointment, which begins August 1, 2020.

**REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:** The successful candidate must hold a juris doctorate from an ABA accredited law school; must have an active law license and be in good standing with the state bar association; must be eligible for appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, or Professor. The candidate must also have experience working with paralegals and knowledge about the paralegal profession.

**PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:** Experience as a program director or instructor in a legal studies program is highly preferred.

## **PRIMARY DUTIES**

- TEACHING: teaches 12 credit hours per academic year; performs duties of a CSM faculty member as identified in the CSM Faculty Handbook;
- ADVISING: Advises legal studies majors; reviews graduation audits prepared by Registrar;
- ADMINISTRATIVE DUTIES: Ensures the program remains accredited by the ABA by fulfilling the accreditation requirements; hires and evaluates adjunct faculty; internship oversight; class scheduling; writes program assessment report; conducts meetings of adjunct faculty, the advisory Board, and the Student Paralegal Association; reviews syllabi, curricula, and courses.
