Primary Purpose of Job

Responsible for ensuring the safety of members and guests when they are in or around the pool and responding to emergencies. Must be professional, attentive, and alert while guarding and patrolling the deck.

Other Responsibilities

Moving the lane ropes for Aqua Aerobics and lap swimmers

Sweeping, scrubbing, and hosing the pool deck and bleachers

Keep the deck and pool area clean of debris and equipment when not in use

Chemical checks during your shift and recording of pool attendance

Qualifications

- Current certifications in American Red Cross Lifeguard Training, First Aid, and CPR for the Professional Rescuer
- Able to work independently and as part of a team
- Knowledge and application of lifeguarding surveillance and rescue techniques

Job Type: Part-time

This job is not part of work study but there will be times you may be able to study if no one is in the pool and other duties have been completed for the shift.

Hours Monday – Friday 8:30am – 3:30pm and shifts can be 2 hours or more
